



Salzburg is a many-faceted city. Once ruled by archbishops, uniting both secular and ecclesiastical power, the city can look back on a moving history. Many baroque church spires, the Cathedral and the Residence with its magnificent state rooms bear witness to a great past.

Today the narrow streets of the historic city center are dominated by a vibrant hustle and bustle. Countless museums and galleries beg to be explored at length. Listen to the music of the street musicians while enjoying a cup of coffee and "Salzburger Nockerl" or take a walk across the city's mountains to take in the spectacular view of the city's surroundings.

Music plays an important role in Salzburg: whether it focuses on W. A. Mozart, whose birthplace and residence are among the city's most popular attractions, "The Sound of Music" or the festivals at Easter, Whitsun or during the summer. Over 4,000 cultural events are held in Salzburg each year: opportunity enough to give in to the charm of the music and the joie de vivre.

Anif - verdant green to the south of Salzburg

Anif lies just outside the gates of the bustling Festival city. Surrounded by lush meadows and fields, the village offers visitors a variety of sports and recreation opportunities, having maintained its rural character despite its close proximity to the city.

Culture, customs and sports

In addition to the Festival city's extensive cultural offerings, a number of traditional events such as Easter markets, country fairs, brass concerts in the castle park, etc. can be found in Anif.
